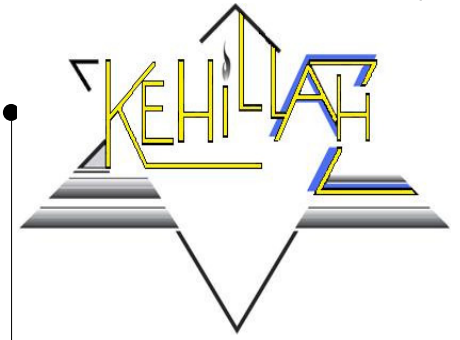

ADULT EDUCATION

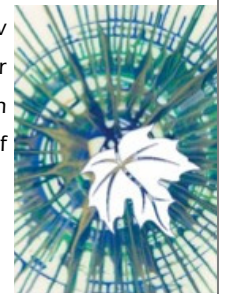
“MAKE YOUR STUDY OF TORAH A FIXED HABIT”
